Established in 2013, The U.S. China Film & Television Association exists to connect two of the most significant entertainment powers, the U.S. and China film and television industries. The organization works to create enormous opportunities for collaboration between the two countries, encouraging growth across technology, finance, investment, and cultural relationships. 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


